MEMBERS FROM SPD

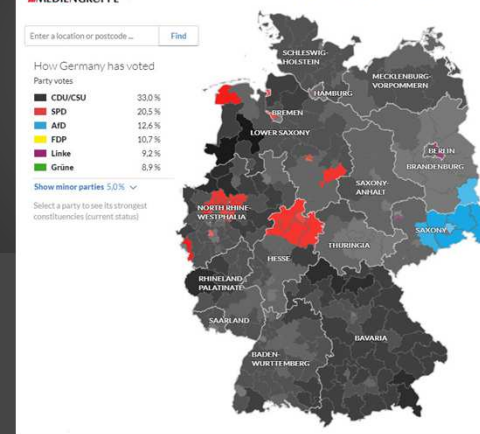
- At the end of 2019 there were 419.340 members of the SPD. This means that the membership has more than halved since 1990.
